

## **FAST START TRAINING**

### **FOR CHURCH LEADERS WORKING WITH SCOUTING**

**Each Ward/Branch should have Fast Start DVDs for Leaders.** Each Ward and Branch should purchase and have on hand the Scout Leader Fast Start DVDs and video tapes for each Scout program. It is vitally important that church leaders working with the Scouting programs, and especially **newly called leaders** in Scouting, Aaronic Priesthood, Primary Presidency, Stake Young Mens Presidency, and Stake Primary Presidency view these DVDs or video tapes as soon as they are called and again as needed so that our efforts on behalf of our young men can be properly focused and directed.

The **Varsity Scout Leader Fast Start** and the **New Venturing Fast Start** DVDs should also be used to **train the members Teacher's Quorum and the Priest's Quorum.**
