

NATIVE AMERICAN Don't just read about Native American life, LIVE IT. Come experience how daily chores and games were done by the true settlers of North America. There are no lectures here! All activities are "hands on." Period archery, lacrosse and a real longhouse highlight this step back in time.

WAGON TRAIN Saddle'em up and move them out, a horse of course. Wagon Train offers the chance to not only ride a horse but to round one up and care for it as well. Once your horse is groomed and saddled head out on the trails that straddle the leeward side off Knob Mountain. Later pack up and head out on a wagon train.

CIVIL WAR Sign up now, your country needs you. Whether you be fight'n to preserve the Union or for your rights in the Confederacy be sure to get the proper training. Report with your team to the Civil War recruiting station to shoot .58 caliber percussion rifles, march in formation and play baseball. Encamp like soldiers did in the War Between the States (circa 1861).

SAILING Enjoy a day out on the lake by feeling the gentle strokes of a breeze and the warmth of the sun. You and members of your team can enjoy the benefits of sailing out on lake Merriweather.

RIFLE AND SHOTGUN Take time to practice your skills at the rifle range and at the shotgun ranges.

MOTORBOATING/WATER SKIING Enjoy time out on the lake learning how to handle a motorboat and then getting up and taking off skiing.

C.O.P.E. Take advantage of this highly challenging C.O.P.E. course. This activity will test you as an individual and your team as a cooperative group.

ROCK CLIMBING - The Rock Climbing Outpost is tough, if you climb to the top you have truly met High Adventure. Safety is always our number one concern at Lenhok'sin but at this Outpost it reaches perfection, whether you are climbing up or repelling down you will be in good hands. Our staff is trained to the tee on B.S.A. policy so even if you are stuck between a rock and a hard place, at the end of your rope or standing on the edge.....well you get the idea.

CAVING - Explore the underground world that the Caving outpost has to offer. The outpost staff will teach you cave conservation and safety but will let you discover what is in the cave and let you find your own way. Crews going caving should bring an extra long sleeve shirt, a pair of long pants and an extra pair of shoes; these items will be delivered to the Outpost for you. Because of scheduling snags all crews attending Lenhok'sin should come prepared to go caving.
